Kindergarten

A is for Automobiles :

Exploring the many aspects of transportation and travel through games and artifacts

Sample vocabulary: transportation, map

B is for Boxes:

Unwrap surprising facts about boxes and how we use them!

Sample vocabulary: storage, display

F is for Fossils/R is for Rock:

Dig into the process of how fossils are formed

Sample vocabulary: fossil, rock

J is for Japan:

A look at the Japanese culture such as design and ceremonial dress

Sample vocabulary: chopsticks, fan

N is for Numismatics:

Money! The "How, What & Whys" of the money used now and in the past

Sample vocabulary: relief, money

M is for Musical Instruments:

Students classify instrument families and discover the "ugly duckling" of the music world

Sample vocabulary: instrument, band

Space:

"3...2...1...BLAST OFF!" Experience what it would be like to be an astronaut while exploring the planets

Sample vocabulary: astronaut, moon

U is for USA:

If you could meet Betsy Ross - what would you ask her?
